Thank you for caring and praying for your missionaries who are bringing the gospel to the Jewish people!

Our staff has been very busy between Passover (April) and Pentecost (June). These past few months have been full of traveling week after week to churches across the nation for presentations, conferences on Jewish evangelism, and discipleship retreats. We also held multiple Passover outreach events in our congregations and centers.

I was encouraged to hear about people coming to faith in Messiah through our missionaries' explaining Jesus' connections to the Jewish holidays. This past Easter, in only one church service, six people put their faith in Jesus after hearing a Messiah in the Passover presentation from one of our staff!

On the other side of the world, our workers are assisting Ukrainian refugees through our ministries in Ukraine, Germany, Poland, and Israel. They have provided food, clothes, housing, financial aid, and transportation to so many. When possible, they have also shared the gospel. Despite the devastation, we see many refugees seeking the Lord and some trusting the Messiah for their salvation through the testimony of our workers!

I am so proud of our missionaries who not only remain committed to their own personal ministries but also serve the needs of others in these desperate times.
